COVID 19 Rule Addendum

08/25/20

This addendum has been developed for the safety and wellbeing of all those in attendance as well as the staff and volunteers. Strict adherence to these rules will be enforced. Those not adhering to the rules as stated below will be asked to leave the show grounds immediately.

We would like to have as few people on the show grounds at one time as possible. Participants and one trainer/assistant only. NO SPECTATORS or non-essential people will be permitted on show grounds. Please plan to arrive with a comfortable amount of time to prepare yourself and your horse for your ride time and plan to depart immediately after you are done competing. For those traveling together, or trainers bringing multiple clients on one trailer, we will be grouping you tightly together for this show. Accommodating big gaps between riders won't be possible at this time.

Participants are required to self-monitor their temperature prior to entering the show grounds. Anyone with a temperature 99.5 or above is not permitted to enter the show grounds.

Anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 2 weeks may not enter the show grounds.

1. Face masks are REQUIRED at all times unless you are on the back of a horse or ringside giving instructions or calling a test.
2. Comply with minimum 6 ft social distancing requirements at all times.
3. NO ONE but the rider and trainer or assistant will be permitted on show grounds. In the case of a minor, 1 parent will also be permitted to attend. No spectators will be permitted, and no seating will be available ringside.
4. Stabling will be extremely limited as our goal is for you to arrive with enough time to prepare for your ride, compete, and depart immediately after. If there are extenuating circumstances and a stall is needed, please contact me to discuss.
5. There will be no snacks or water offered at this show so please plan accordingly.
6. Please wash hands regularly and adhere to other sanitization practices.
7. No more than 3 riders to a warmup ring at a time and no more than 3 trainers/assistants ringside at a time, properly social distancing.
8. Only one person at a time may approach the office or test pick up area.
